In the run-up to the school summer holidays so that families and young people receive water safety information at the most relevant time of year.

Drowning is one of the leading causes of accidental death in the UK and Ireland. According to the National Water Safety Forum's WAID (Water Incident Database), an average of around 270 people die each year from accidental drowning in the UK, with summer months and inland waters such as rivers, quarries, and reservoirs particularly dangerous. Globally, the World Health Organization estimates that drowning kills around 300,000 people each year, making it one of the largest causes of unintentional injury death worldwide. The vast majority of incidents are preventable with basic knowledge of water safety.



## ALWAYS FOLLOW THE WATER SAFETY CODE

Whenever you are around water:

### STOP AND THINK

Take time to assess your surroundings.  
Look for the dangers and always research local signs and advice.



### STAY TOGETHER

When around water always go with friends or family.  
Swim at a lifeguarded venue.



In an emergency:

### CALL 999

If you are at the coast, call 999 and ask for the Coastguard.  
Don't enter the water to rescue.



### FLOAT

Fall in or become tired - stay calm, float on your back and call for help.  
Throw something that floats to somebody that has fallen in.
